In 1935, the Commonwealth of the Philippines was establish with the U.S. approval and Manuel Quezon was elected the country first president.

To celebrate the day a parade is always happening in Manila headed by the country's incumbent president, followed by a speech and a 21-gun salute. Many Filipinos spend the day in parks and malls. Government offices are closed on this day, there are no schools.
